Our strategic focus is on urging lawmakers to handle the decision making process in a responsible way, rather than rushing it thru in a sneaky, unaccountable manner during Lame Duck Session. We want to engage as many fellow citizens as possible in urging a responsible process, no matter where they may fall on the spectrum regarding Line 5, tunnel proposal, Bridge Authority etc.

LTE TALKING POINTS

- Regardless of where one stands regarding Line 5 and the proposed tunnel, Republicans, Independents, Democrats etc. can ALL agree that we deserve good governance and thoughtful deliberation before a decision is made.
- Rushing such a hugely important decision thru between an election and the holidays during Lame Duck Session is bad governance. It is unethical and harmful to our communities.
- All stakeholders deserve a seat at the table on the Line 5 issue. By pushing a major decision on Line 5 thru during the holidays, Lansing is perpetuating broken politics and allowing for little public input and even less accountability. We deserve better!
